# <u>Report</u> Division: County-wide

After review of Policy 2.14, Administration is recommending to Council that this be considered a procedure rather than policy and that the form in this policy be added as an appendix to Procurement Policy 2.1. Under "Employee Responsibilities" in the Procurement Policy, it states "Employees are responsible for evaluating the performance of suppliers and reviewing available performance evaluations for bidding suppliers prior to purchase as per Wheatland County's Performance Management Policy 2.14." Administration recommends that the words "as per Wheatland County's Performance Management Policy 2.14." be removed the next time the Procurement policy is brought forward for Council's review. A note has been made in the current Procurement Policy with this proposed amendment.
