Local Radio System upgrade

THAT Council approve Bearcom as the project manager for the upgrade of the local radio system and install of the Hammer Hill radio tower.

The current local radio system has several flaws, the County has budgeted \$275,000.00 for an upgrade of the local radio system and install of a new tower.

Since 2017 the County has been working with Bearcom on this project (timeline attached), since that time the County has purchased numerous pieces of equipment that are currently at the Bearcom Warehouse. Bearcom has also ordered equipment including the tower and batteries to complete this project, it is currently stored at their warehouse ready to be installed.

In 2019 Council commissioned a report by Transitional Solutions Inc. (TSI) to do a comparison between transitioning to the Alberta First Responders Radio Communications System (AFRRCS) or to continue with the upgrade the local system.

At the planning and priorities meeting Tuesday, July 14, 2020 the radio comparison report was presented to Council, it was decided that administration would move forward with the upgrade to the local radio system and the install of the new tower at Hammer Hill.
