

BYLAW 2020-14

BEING A BYLAW OF WHEATLAND COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING THE WHEATLAND COUNTY AND SPECIAL AREAS BOARD INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 230, 606, 631 AND 692 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, CHAPTER M-26, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS Section 631(1) of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 requires that two or more Councils of municipalities that have common boundaries must, by each passing a Bylaw, adopt an intermunicipal development plan.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Wheatland County wishes to adopt an intermunicipal development plan in consultation with the Special Areas Board to be compliant with the recent amendments to the Municipal Government Act (MGA), Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26.

AND WHEREAS the municipality must prepare a corresponding bylaw and provide for its consideration at a public hearing.

AND WHEREAS a Public Hearing was held on _____ at the Wheatland County office.

NOW THEREFORE under the authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, the Council of Wheatland County enacts as follows:

1. Council shall adopt the Wheatland County and Special Areas Board Intermunicipal Development Plan, as attached and forming part of this bylaw.
2. This Bylaw comes into force when it receives third reading and is signed by the Reeve/Deputy Reeve and the CAO or Designate as per the *Municipal Government Act*.
3. The Wheatland County and Special Areas Board Intermunicipal Development Plan comes into force when Wheatland County gives third readings to Bylaw 2020-14.
4. The Wheatland County and Special Areas Board Intermunicipal Development Plan comes into force when the Minister of Municipal Affairs issues a Ministerial Order.
