# Key Issue(s) / Concepts Defined

First reading of Bylaw 2019-40 was held January 14, 2020 and now a Public Hearing must be held, after which the Bylaw and associated documents will be sent to Alberta Transportation for review and Ministerial approval, to be followed by 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of the Bylaw at a future meeting of Council.

The proposed area of closure is 0.49 acres. This portion of original road allowance was never developed as road, nor is it planned to be developed due to topographic and natural waterway issues. The proposed closure will not result in any land becoming inaccessible. The closed area would be sold and consolidated.

# Relevant Policy / Practices / Legislation

MGA Section 22 permits the closure of road plans under municipal control by Bylaw. Road Closure Bylaws require 1st reading followed by a Public Hearing and circulations to agencies and adjacent landowners, submission to the Minister of Alberta Transportation for Ministerial approval, then return to Council for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> readings. Council Policy 9.5.4 permits and offers guidelines for the closure of undeveloped roads.
